Despite losing a number of key players, their blend of skill and experience, has set them apart as one of the top teams in the league. Our U14 Whites added a number of new players at the start of the season, but this hasn't stopped them as they sit in second place in their league and have made it through to the Middlesex Youth Trophy quarter-finals.

These teams continue to develop both individually and collectively, which is particularly pleasing for the U15 Reds who added 8 new players at the start of the season.
